Types of Plans

Copay Focus

Higher premium plans with first dollar coverage, copays for most services and \$0 medical deductible.

Available in: All states except New Jersey and New Mexico

Advantage

Higher premium, with lower deductibles and cost shares (copay) for many services; may also include extras, such as gym access.

Available in: All states except Indiana and Nebraska

Standard

CMS and/or state-based marketplaces require all carriers to offer these plans. Plan designs and cost-shares are prescribed, allowing consumers to more easily shop on price, network and product extras.

Available in: All states where UnitedHealthcare offers Individual Exchange plans

Value

Go-to flagship plan and a good fit for most. Offered across all levels with moderate deductibles but lower premiums. Plan has both copays and coinsurance. Includes additional benefits such as pre-deductible coverage with copay, including low-cost, Tier 2 generic medications.

Available in: All states where we offer Individual Exchange plans

Essential

Lower premium, with higher deductible and cost shares at time of service. Basic coverage for serious illness and injury.

Available off-exchange only: Arizona, Colorado, Maryland, Ohio and Texas

Kelsey-Sebold Clinic

Plan specific to providers who are contracted with Kelsey-Seybold Clinic locations in the Houston area. Members have an assigned PCP from the clinic network.

Available in: 6 Texas counties - Brazoria, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Montgomery and Walker

Sanitas Medical Center

Plan specific to providers who are contracted with Kelsey-Seybold Clinic locations in the Houston area. Members have an assigned PCP from the clinic network.
