

## Introducing our New Clinical Review Process

Standardized and Efficient!

We are pleased to announce changes with our clinical review process that will bring efficiency and consistency of experience when you interact with our Care Advocates.

## Enhancements we have made:

- Clinical reviews are standardized for a consistent experience
- Our system captures the right amount of information for each case
- Streamlined information capturing for maximum efficiency
- Information from previous reviews will carry forward to make successive reviews even faster

## What you can expect from our new process:

- We have standardized the information collection process so that your experience will be efficient and consistent for all patients
- Facility feedback indicates the information we capture is very similar to the information in facility systems
- A greater focus on live reviews to complete clinical conversations and care coordination in one call, saving time and avoiding call backs
