


NILC Provider Defined



What is considered a Non-Independently Licensed Clinician?

Non-Independently Licensed Clinician (NILC) Defined

- A NILC provider is one that can not practice independently as outlined in the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) Behavioral Health Service Provider Manual. This includes provisionally licensed clinicians.

Chapter 2: Behavioral Health Service Section 2.3: Outpatient Services

A licensed mental health professional (LMHP) is an individual who is licensed in the State of Louisiana to diagnose and treat mental illness or substance use, acting within the scope of all applicable state laws and their professional license.

A LMHP includes the following individuals who are licensed to practice independently:

Medical Psychologists

Licensed Psychologists

Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSWs)

Licensed Professional Counselors (LPCs)

Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists (LMFTs)

Licensed Addiction Counselors (LACs)


Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRNs)
