Re: Behavioral Health Services for New York Under 21 Medicaid Recipients

On January 1, 2019 the New York State Department of Health (NYS DOH) began to transition Behavioral Health Services covered for eligible Under 21 Medicaid recipients to Medicaid Managed Care Organizations (MCOs).

The UnitedHealthcare Community Plan current benefit package will cover additional mental health and substance use disorder services for Under 21 Medicaid recipients. Optum is collaborating in the administration of benefits related to the full continuum of Mental Health (MH) and Substance Use Disorders (SUD) services for eligible Under 21 Medicaid recipients served by Community Plan and covered under the New York Medicaid State Plan. These services are being implemented in phases.

In accordance with New York State guidance around Continuity of Service to Under 21 Medicaid members a 90 day transition of care will apply. Providers who are not yet participating in our network may continue to deliver services to Community Plan members for a period of 24-months from the Behavioral Health Benefit Inclusion Date at the Medicaid fee-for-service rate.

Out-of-network providers must notify UnitedHealthcare ahead of the July 1, 2019 effective date regarding which members you anticipate serving for those services that go live on July 1, 2019. Taking this action will minimize disruption to member care and provider payment.
