MassHealth requires CANS assessments for members under age 21



Assessment Reminder

This alert serves as a reminder that all network (contracted) providers/clinicians are required to complete the Child & Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) behavioral health assessment for MassHealth members under the age of 21 before providing any of the following services:

- Psychiatric inpatient hospitalization
- Community-Based Acute Treatment (CBAT)
- Psychiatric inpatient hospitalization
- Intensive Care Coordination (ICC)
- In Home Therapy (IHT)
- Outpatient Therapy (diagnostic evaluations, individual, family, and group therapy)



Training and Certification Required

In order to administer the CANS assessment, providers/clinicians are required to complete the CANS training and certification if:

- They are enrolled as a network provider with Optum Behavioral Health or another of MassHealth's contracted managed care entities, and
- Serve children and youth under the age of 21.

Complete the CANS Training

Once you have completed registration and successfully logged in to the site, you will be able to access the Massachusetts CANS online training, certification exam and additional CANS-related information and support.
