Summary - I

Have we achieved Pareto Optimality/Efficiency in Transplantation? Depends on our perspective...

- **Yes.** If we believe that in the current distribution, all resources have been exhausted, and there is no possible change in allocation that benefits all dimensions. But **we would then need to agree that:**
 - we have achieved, at best, a *weak* Pareto optimality/efficiency such that a Pareto optimal improvement is only possible if the alternate allocation and resulting distribution would be strictly preferred by all (even if it leaves at least one individual unchanged and makes at least one individual worse off).
 - the current distribution constitutes a constrained Pareto optimality/efficiency where the 'planner' is not able to improve upon the efficiency of the distribution because of imperfect information (assumes benevolence versus government failure).
- **No.** If we believe that all resources have not been exhausted, or that there are possible Pareto optimal improvements that can make at least one individual better off, without making even a single individual worse off. In that case, we would need to better qualify what resources have not been exhausted – factor(s), and what constitutes being better or worse off – waiting time, survival, QOL before and after transplantation... [Note that it is assumed that the 'individual' is the patient, and that the Final Rule defines what is meant by being better or worse off – access to a transplant for the 'sickest' patient].

The Significance of Age and Frailty in Pancreas Transplant Candidate

- In pancreas transplantation, age is known to be the most significant risk factor for adverse outcomes post-transplant
 - Outcomes are worse in older vs younger transplant recipients (Foley et al., 2005).
- Diabetes may further increase the risk of negative outcomes





Pharmacogenomics is an important part of precision medicine; it is the study of how genetic makeup can affect a person's response to a drug. Health care professionals (HCPs) can use pharmacogenomic information to help decide the most appropriate treatment for each individual. Direct-to-Consumer Genetic Testing: Providing Personalized Medicine

Genetic testing, marketed directly to customers, has become more and more prevalent and is expanding the number of people who are obtaining information about their DNA (or genome). Consumers send in a DNA sample and receive their results directly; in most cases, bypassing a health care professional (HCP). Consumers may receive confusing or unexpected results and may be in need of competent guidance from a knowledgeable HCP.
