Completing the Readiness Assessment Tool is a required element for becoming an in-network provider of IOP. The Readiness Assessment Tool is designed to assist your organization and Optum in determining your current resources, capabilities, and needs related to the development and implementation of IOP services. It should take approximately two hours for you to gather the necessary information and complete the tool.

Following the live webinar, the link to the Readiness Assessment will be available on the o*ptumidaho.com* website, under "Network Providers" and "Provider Training." The assessment will be open March 15 - March 29, 2017.

The first wave of IOP implementation will occur in June 2017. The subsequent implementation phases will occur later in 2017 and in 2018. **To be credentialed for each wave, providers must complete the Readiness Assessment Tool.** Feedback and additional information will then be communicated.
