

Alert Summary: This alert details changes within the Optum Supports and Services (OSSM) system to remind targeted care coordinators of upcoming person-centered serviced plan renewal dates.


This alert does not detail any new Targeted Care Coordination (TCC) processes; rather it provides information about an enhancement within OSSM.

Dear Provider.

We appreciate your participation in the TCC program. TCC aims to improve access to necessary services and create collaboration between formal and informal support systems of youth and families. This process involves the creation of a person-centered service plan (PCSP), which is renewed annually. To help facilitate awareness of PCSP renewal dates, Optum staff will begin adding an Alert notification in the Alerts tab of a member's OSSM record when that member's plan is due for renewal within 120 days. It will look like this:



When the user clicks the pencil icon under the word 'Actions,' the screen will look like this and will include a note regarding the active plan's renewal date:



Please note that the annual renewal of the PCSP is a federal requirement for members enrolled in Medicaid's YES Program. Members who do not have an annual PCSP update will not be able to maintain eligibility for the YES Program. Additional federal requirements of the YES Program are:

- 1. Completion of an annual assessment with the Independent Assessor within 364 days of the previous assessment.
- 2. Use of a 1915(i) (YES Program) specific service at least one time per plan year. This service must be included within the PCSP. Currently, Respite is the only 1915(i) (YES Program) specific service.
