#### Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) Enhancement and training updates:

Optum Idaho offers Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) Verbal Intervention training and certification at no cost to all in-network providers. These trainings are offered in a blended learning environment with ondemand training modules via Optum Idaho Relias Learning, prior to a live (webinar) certification.

The Education team is excited to announce that we have enhanced the CPI training by integrating trauma intervention components into the existing Verbal Intervention trainings starting in June 2022.

CPI certification is required for providers who provide Crisis Intervention services and are not independently licensed. Please remember that you are required to complete a two-hour CPI Refresher course every *two* years to keep your CPI certification up-to-date and to continue providing crisis intervention services to members.
